
INVITATION

The latest research paper on the effectiveness of radio drama competitions titled "Enrich Competencies for Sustainability through Radio Drama Competitions: A Multiyear Cross-sectional Study in Hong Kong" was published on Feb 13, 2024 on Vol. 13(1), 2024 of Journal of Curriculum and Teaching of Sciedu Press. The study aims to investigate how participation in radio drama competitions can foster collaboration, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills within the sustainable development framework proposed by UNESCO. In addition, Smart Education has also published an essay in 2022 titled "Radio Drama Competition as an Effective Tool to Boost the Motivation and Self-Confidence of Primary and Secondary School English Learners in Hong Kong" on Vol. 15(1), 2022 of English Language Teaching of Canadian Center of Science and Education, exploring the impact of radio drama competitions on enhancing students' motivation, self-confidence, and cooperation in language learning for primary and secondary school students in Hong Kong.

The participants will be divided into two levels, primary and secondary. The shortlisted teams from each level will be invited to showcase their talents and perform their English Radio Drama LIVE. **NO participation fee is needed in this competition**, thanks to the generous support from our sponsors, including SCOLAR, Educational Testing Service

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER:

Students attending full-time schools in Hong Kong are eligible to enter the competition. Students can form a team of no more than 5 members and submit a 5-minute play script of a radio drama program with the above theme. Teams will represent their schools, and each school can have more than one team to participate. Each team can only submit one entry for the competition. Teams entering the second phase of the competition will be asked to record their radio drama program in mp3 format and submit to us before the deadline.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Each team shall not submit more than one script.
- Each team must consist of no more than 5 students. Members of a team must be of the same level as listed (i.e. a group consist of Primary School and Secondary School students is **not allowed**.)

- 3. Any entries with obscene, violent, malicious or discriminatory elements or involving publicity of or advocating any persons or groups and illegal and unlawful act shall be disqualified.
- 4. Play scripts must be of original content, and materials taken from pre-existing scripts by writers who are not part of the team are prohibited. Entrants who fail to comply will be disqualified.
- 5. Entrants will be solely responsible for the content and any violations of copyright as a result of posting it.
- 6. Entries will not be returned to the contestants.
- 7. The organizer has the right to use, broadcast, share or re-use all entries of the competition.
- 8. Participation in the competition will constitute the participants' consent to the organizer's use of the participants' names, likeness, voices, opinions, photos, scripts, audio, video, performance and information for promotional purposes in any media, worldwide; or authorization for other parties to use and edit the above materials for educational purposes or publicity, without further payment or notification.
- 9. The organizer shall own the intellectual property rights of all entries.
- 10. Extra certificates will not be given to any replacement members of a team.
- 11. The decision of the adjudicators regarding the competition results shall be final. Entrants shall have no right to raise objections. The organizer reserves the right to make final decisions on all aspects of the competition.
